Introduction. Hyper-reactivity to auditory stimuli is a common problem in children with autistic spectrum disorder (ASD). Bromley, Hare, Davison, and Emerson (2004) reported that 70% of children with ASD exhibit hyper-sensitivity to auditory stimuli.
